

45th Annual CSU Bull & Female Sale

The 45th Annual Colorado State University Bull and Female Sale was held on February 19th, 2022 at Centennial Livestock Auction in Fort Collins, Colorado. Buyers from Colorado, Wyoming, Nebraska, and Texas took home 27 high-quality, high-performing bulls for an average price of \$4,376 and 16 high-quality bred females for an average price of \$1934. The highest selling bull was an Angus bull sired by S A V Resource 1441 that sold for \$7,000; the highest selling female was a Hereford heifer sired by /S Mandate 66589 that sold for \$2,650.

This year's sale was sold by Tom Frey with Centennial Livestock Auction, Fort Collins, Colorado.

The high selling Angus bull was also the high selling bull overall. Lot 4, sired by S A V Resource 1441 sold for \$7,000. The top selling Hereford bull, lot 13, was sired by /S Mandate 66589 and sold for \$6,250. Angus females averaged \$2,117, and the high seller, sired by Raven Powerball 53, sold for \$2,350. Hereford females averaged \$2,133, and the high seller, sired by /S Mandate 66589, sold for \$2,650. Ten, fancy black baldy females averaged \$1,820.
