



Wheat streak mosaic virus (WSMV)

- Wheat curl mite (WCM)-transmitted viruses are widespread across the High Plains.
- WSMV is the most commonly found wheat virus among the three WCM-transmitted viruses.
- Characteristic symptoms of WSMV are small-elongated chlorotic lesions on leaves.
- Symptoms are more severe when WSMV occurs with other viruses.
