**** Sample Retention Policy & Disclaimer**

1. Federal and State regulations require that all seed labelers retain a file sample for two years. The Colorado Seed Lab will retain the entire sample submitted to the lab for one year. Due to storage restrictions, after 1 year a subsample or file sample (approximately 100 grams) will be retained to comply with federal regulations, however the remaining volume of seed will be disposed of in a manner that no longer retains the identity of the seed submitted.
2. Within the first year of possession of a sample, customers may request that excess seed be returned after testing (charges may apply), but the lab will retain some seed to comply with federal regulations. In most cases, the file samples can be used for additional tests at customer request, or be useful in seed label compliance or legal matters. After 2 years the remaining sample amount will be destroyed.
